SIS Policy Plan Recap



● SIS Objectives



● Continuing Emphasis Areas

- » Reaffirm statutory intent for *interregional, interstate, and international* travel
- » Continue emphasis on *largest and most strategic facilities*

SIS Policy Implementation Status



- **SIS designation and data review**
 - » Modal Data
 - » Highway Data
- **Refine Freight Hub Facilities and Criteria**
- **Refine Passenger Hub Facilities and Criteria**
- **SIS and Complete Streets**
- **MAF Study Initiated**

SIS Designation and Data Review



- **Updating modal and highway activity data**
- **Began a SIS highway designation review**
- **Evaluating rail corridor data**
- **Evaluating change to Florida totals in measuring facility eligibility**

Refine Freight Hubs



- **Freight hub criteria**

- » For more than just rail terminals, potentially including:
 - Intermodal Logistics Centers (ILCs)
 - Warehousing or logistics clusters
- » For emerging facilities that support catalytic economic development opportunities

Refine Passenger Hubs



- **Passenger hub criteria**

- » Encourage co-location with other SIS hubs or major passenger terminals
 - Include provisions for pedestrian, bicyclists and transit vehicles
 - Improve synchronization and connectivity between SIS modes

SIS and FDOT Complete Streets



- **Reviewing existing Complete Streets Policy and Implementation documents.**
- **Reconciling SIS with the FDOT Complete Streets Policy**
- **Reach out to FDOT districts and MPOs to see what they have in place that considers managing a context-sensitive system.**

SIS Military Access Facility Study



- **Purpose:**

- » Assess of the impacts of proposed improvements to SIS corridors on or near military installations

- **Schedule:**

- » Review data and policy, December 2016
- » Conduct site visits, January/February 2017
- » Draft Report, March/April 2017
- » Full Study Completed, May 2017
